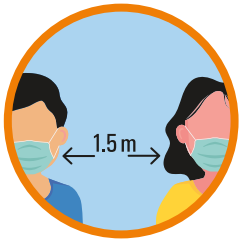
TEMPERATURE CONTROLS

Temperature controls will be carried out before entering the halls. Anyone with a fever or high temperature will not have access to the event.



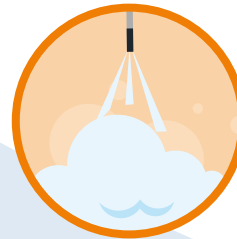
MOUTH COVERS

Cotton mouth covers will be required for all attendees and staff. We will provide cotton masks for attendees.



REGISTRATION AREA

We will reduce the registration lines and keep the required distance of 1.5 meters or 6 feet. We will have plexiglass shields to be placed at each station. There will be large hallways to prevent attendees from colliding with each other.



GLOVES AND HAND DISINFECTANTS

We will have gloves for each attendant and gel hand sanitizer.



DISINFECTANTS NEBULIZERS

The hotel's ventilation system will apply disinfectants to purify the air.



MINI-MEETINGS

Mini-meetings will be designed to allow social distancing measures and a plexiglas shield will be placed on all tables.



GENERAL SESSION

Conference rooms will be configured to allow a space of 1.5 meters or 6 feet between chairs. The display area, tables and other space will also have 6 foot or 1.5 meter space markers for attendees to follow.



INDOOR / OUTDOOR SPACES

We will have adequate distancing measures so that we can coexist harmoniously for the welcome cocktail, the inauguration, the air show, as well as for the closing dinner.



DRINKS AND FOODS

To avoid contact between the diner and the food or drinks, the hotel staff will serve to the attendees their food, as well as the coffee break with gloves, mouth covers or masks and protective equipment. Non-alcoholic beverages and other take-out items will be ready and disinfected at the receptions for maximum security.
